

**Dear Customer,**

Pursuant to Point 5.3 of the General Terms of Contract, we hereby inform you that the following provisions of the General Terms of Contract of iData Kft. are modified as of 1 March 2017.

Registered office: 1103 Budapest, Gergely utca 112/C.

Point 2.5 The Customer may request the temporary cessation of the service after the expiration of the contract concluded for a definite term. In this case, instead of the monthly fees set out in the contract, the Customer shall pay a monthly cessation fee of HUF 1,000.-, which also includes the costs of maintenance of the GSM SIM cards. In this case, the service can be restored immediately and free of charge. The temporary cessation of contracts made for an indefinite term may be requested on a maximum of 2 occasions a year and for a duration of at least one month on each occasion, however, the total duration of temporary cessation may not exceed six months annually. The Service Provider may decide at its own discretion whether or not to approve a cessation request during the term of an indefinite contract. If the Service Provider approves the cessation, the term of the contract will be extended by the duration of the cessation. The frequency and duration of temporary cessation shall be regulated in accordance with the rules concerning contracts made for an indefinite term.

Point 4.1: If the contract is concluded for a definite term, the guarantee period covers the entire term of the contract. Should the contract concluded for a definite period of time become indefinite after the expiry of the definite period, the guarantee may be used exclusively during the definite period of time. In the case of contracts made for an indefinite term, the Service Provider provides a 12-month guarantee for each installed device. Under no circumstances and in no way shall the guarantee period be extended even in the case of devices in respect of which the Service Provider has fulfilled its repair or replacement obligation within the scope of the guarantee. The Parties may agree on a different guarantee period in an individual contract.

Point 4.3: In the event that the Customer and the Service Provider agree to extend the contract after the expiration of its definite term by entering into another contract for a definite term, the guarantee period will be valid for the entire term of the new contract only if the Parties explicitly provide so in their individual contract.

Point 6.1: Invoices shall be issued in accordance with the relevant provisions of Act CXXVII of 2007 on Value Added Tax.

Regarding Point 5.4 of the General Terms of Contract, we call our Customers' attention to the following:

Should the modified version of the General Terms of Contract contain provisions that are substantially more disadvantageous for the Customer than the former provisions, the Customer shall have the right to terminate the individual contract upon 30 days written notice within 15 days of the date of communication of the modification.
